First to Leave

Lee Norman, a young butcher of Omro, and Ernest Kramer, a Neenah baker, have volunteered to be the first men to enter the service of their country through the draft route and they will make the five per cent of the Winnebago county quota, making it unnecessary for any other drafted man to leave for camp until another call comes. The young men have been ordered to report before the local exemption board tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock and will be under the care of the board until they leave the city Saturday morning at 7:50 o'clock. Mayor Clark of Neenah is planning to entertain the young men in the proper manner and in accordance with the plan which has been carried out in many other cities throughout the United States. The action of Messrs. Norman and Kramer in volunteering to be the first to go from this county is a most commendable one and they deserve a rousing reception at the hands of our citizens.
