

DIES AT HOSPITAL

Mrs. Ottilge Woldt Passes Away Following Illness of Over a Year — Funeral Saturday.

Mrs. Ottilge Woldt, wife of Julius Woldt, 1639 Oregon street, died early this morning at 12:20 o'clock at the Mercy hospital after an illness of over a year.

Mrs. Woldt was born April 7, 1866, in Germany and came to this country with her parents when she was 5 years of age, settling at Menasha. She lived at Menasha until her marriage to Julius Woldt, which took place Oct. 8, 1885. For the last forty-two years she had been a resident of Oshkosh. She was a member of the Ladies' Aid society of the Eighth Street Lutheran church.

She is survived by her husband; five daughters, Mrs. Otto Brunck, Mrs. Ernst Galow, Mrs. John Harnitz, Mrs. John Eichmann and Miss Edna Woldt, all of this city; and two sons, Arthur and Harvey Woldt, both of this city. She is also survived by three sisters, Mrs. Carl Luebke of Neenah, Mrs. Anna Maasz of this city and Mrs. Carl Prilepp of Seymour; one brother, William Karrow of Menasha, and fifteen grand-children.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the home and at 2 o'clock at the Eighth Street Lutheran church. Rev. C. J. Lange will officiate. Interment will be at the Lutheran cemetery.
