Neenah — Herman Kuchenbecker, 78, 223 E. Franklin avenue, died unexpectedly at his home at 7:45 this morning.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon at Trinity Lutheran church, Neenah, with the Rev. G. A. Schaefer in charge. Burial will be in Oak Hill cemetery.

Mr. Kuchenbecker was born Feb. 25, 1875, in Germany. He came to the United States and the Neenah area in 1890, moving to Neenah in 1916.

He worked for the Soo Line railroad until 1929. From 1929 to 1950 he worked for the Bergstrom Paper mills.
